Required qualifications

Candidates must have an earned doctorate in nursing or related field; Master's in Nursing required if doctorate not in nursing; a record or evidence of potential for scholarly productivity; and eligibility for licensure in Illinois as a Registered Nurse.

Preferred qualifications

We seek candidates with expertise in the following

- Family, Pediatric, Women's Health Nurse Practitioner or Certified Nurse Midwife
- Adult Health, Medical/Surgical Nursing
- Clinical Simulation

Individuals with expertise outside these areas are welcome to apply.
