	<b>Initial Completion Timeframe</b>
	<b><i>MSN, PhD, DNP Students</i></b> Prior to enrolling in first clinical/residency/practicum course.
	<b>Requirement Details</b>
	Initial requirement: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students may submit documentation of any of the following:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Two-Step done within the past year</li> <li>• Two-Step done in previous years with annual One-Steps done to present</li> <li>• One-Steps from the past 3 years</li> <li>• QuantiFERON Gold test done in past year</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <b><i>Special Circumstances</i></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If a student has a positive reaction to the TB skin test, he/she must get a chest x-ray to rule out TB. The student must submit a copy of the chest x-ray report along with a Positive Reactor form (symptom checklist). Chest x-rays are not required on an annual basis; however, the Positive Reactor form is required annually. Chest x-rays have no expiration, therefore no update needed.</li> </ul>
	<b>Acceptable Proof of Completion</b>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Documentation showing dates TB tests administered, read, and the results.</li> <li>• A copy of the QuantiFERON Gold test lab report showing a negative result.</li> <li>• A copy of the chest x-ray and Positive Reactor form.</li> </ul>
	<b>Frequency of Renewal</b>
Annually.  One year from the date the TB test was administered the previous year. *Students must ensure that they complete and submit the update by one year from the date the TB test was administered.  *According to IDPH, if a student is even one day late in getting the TB One step, he/she must do a Two Step or QuantiFERON Gold Test.
