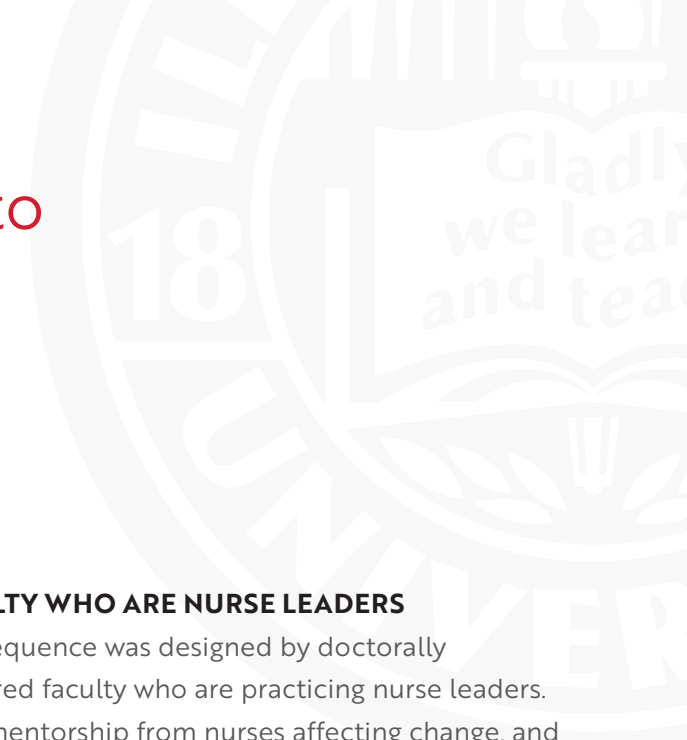
ABOUT THIS SEQUENCE

ONLINE WITH ENGAGED FACULTY

MASTER’S DEGREE STOP-OUT OPTION

After completing NUR 483, students obtain a Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) and may elect to exit the program or take a break and come back within a year with no re-application or fee.
