All students are required to complete 26 credit hours to meet certificate requirements. Students may be required to complete additional coursework to meet the requirements of the certificate (NUR 401 Theoretical Foundations, NUR 437 Pathophysiology, NUR 407 Research, NUR 433 Pharmacotherapeutics, NUR 511 Health Policy, NUR 405 Epidemiology). This certificate is typically completed in two years.

Individual plans of study are developed based on applicable transfer credits from the student's previous graduate nursing master's program, as determined through a gap analysis conducted by the program director.
